- 6. Keller Canyon Mitigation Grant waiting on approval; looking to start sports camps; will also be able to provide free swim lessons; will find out in the next 10 days

Bay Point Youth Academy participated in the Memorial Day Parade; provided free snow cones and toys to the community; 9 academy members received outstanding student awards; academy members will be participating in the East Bay Regional Parks Teen Eco Camp where they will be doing community service, classes, and recreational activities; Teen Center is preparing for the big opening
