The General Manager gave brief reports on the following topics:

- 1. Lynbrook Park two new tables have been installed; new bollards installed; leaking drinking fountain has been repaired; deteriorating light pole has been ordered and will be replaced once received
- 2. Ambrose Park consulting with Pittsburg engineers for Ambrose Park Phase II whom have provided a list of quality certified design consultants that the District can RFP for designs
- Clearland Property Supplemental PSA has been signed by all parties
- 4. Auditorium replacement of ceiling tile, removal of non-functioning A/C units, and painting is almost complete; auditorium will be closed between November 18th thru December 2nd for floor maintenance; new window curtains will be installed December 2nd; board room will also be getting a few updates
- 5. Anuta vandalism at the park; pulled wires from electrical and irrigation and broke PG&E meter; will be having a fence installed to block access
- 6. Green Infrastructure Project the District has been granted the \$2.7 million Prop 1 Implementation Grant for the Ambrose Center Park; it will enhance park facilities and provide environmental benefits
